1858	mid July	Wandsworth, MDX	in magistrates court	Four ragged and sun-burnt children, who gave the names of <i>Elias Shaw, Mark Aaron, Mary Balding</i> , and <i>Martha Balding</i> , her sister, were charged with begging. - Police constable Payne, V division, said that on Sunday afternoon [18th] he was on duty at Barnes-common, with another officer, when he saw a great many gipsy children begging of the foot passengers passing to and from the railway station. He also saw them on the Richmond-road begging of persons in carriages and other vehicles. They kept running at the side of them, some turning heels over head, and others jumping in front of the horses. Several gentlemen had to use their whips before they would go away. There were at least twelve of these children, and as these prisoners were older than the others, he took them into custody. He heard one boy complaining of not having received his share of the money, and he was told that he had 7½d., and had ought not to grumble, He did not find any money upon the prisoners, as they gave it to the younger ones to prevent them losing any while turning heels over head. There had been a great many complaints of the nuisance, and that was the first Sunday witness had been placed there in plain clothes. - A lady attended to speak on behalf of the children. She said Aaron had no parents, but only a grandmother to look after him. She thought the persons who gave them money were greatly to blame. - The parents of the other children said it was not their wish they should beg. They worked hard for their living. The lady said they all lived in tents upon the common, and made mats and brushes. - Mr. Ingham said they also sent their children out to beg. He agreed with the lady, that the public were to blame for giving them money, as it was most destructive to them. The parents did not seem able to take care of them, and therefore he must punish them as an example.
