Her name was Avis Lee and for six-and-twenty years she had settled at Rosherville as an avowed fortune-teller She had two sons serving at Delhi at the time of the late Indian Mutiny, and they were among the 17 rescued by the Highlanders, under Lord Clyde, when the rest of the companions had been massacred With the red handkerchief gracefully twisted round her head, from which a mass of black corkscrew curls flowed down in picturesque profusion, she often supplied artists with a study. Her successor is a daughter who has not yet reached her twentieth year.
