During the whole of that time she used the most foul epithets and threatened to knock the grave stones down her throat if she would come down stairs Henrietta, the complainant's daughter, ten years of age, corroborated her mother's evidence, and was awoke by the noise and shocked by the inelegant dialect so peculiar to that locality The defendant said the "bother" had begun when she went to fetch her husband from "public" and called a female witness named Brown who only heard of a "pat on the head" and "knocking out of teeth promised." - The Magistrates said the evidence was very conflicting and dismissed the case with a caution that all future complainants and defendants would be bound over to keep the peace The police inspector gave a disgraceful account of the district.
