1868	mid August	Oxford, OXF	in magistrates court	<i>Beecheney Baskerfield</i> , a female married member of the nomadic tribe, formerly so well known on the "Marsh," was charged with threatening to do bodily harm to Jane, the wife of Hiram Bowell, in the parish of Cowley, on 3rd instant. The complainant stated that the defendant had come to the door of her house in Magdalen-road at ten o'clock on Monday night and remained outside until two o'clock on Tuesday morning. During the whole of that time she used the most foul epithets and threatened to knock the grave stones down her throat if she would come down stairs. - Henrietta, the complainant's daughter, ten years of age, corroborated her mother's evidence, and was awoke by the noise and shocked by the inelegant dialect so peculiar to that locality. - The defendant said the "bother" had begun when she went to fetch her husband from "public" and called a female witness named Brown who only heard of a "pat on the head" and "knocking out of teeth promised." - The Magistrates said the evidence was very conflicting and dismissed the case with a caution that all future complainants and defendants would be bound over to keep the peace. - The police inspector gave a disgraceful account of the district.	<i>The Bicester Herald</i> , 21 August 1868, 7
