1890	7 October	Abingdon, BRK	in magistrates court as witness	Annie Wainwright, a show woman, of diminutive stature, hailing from Staffordshire, was charged with being drunk and disorderly and assaulting Henry Bailey. - Defendant : I beg your pardon ; I was not drunk. - Superintendent Robotham said defendant made a disturbance on two occasions after the shows came in on Sunday, and on Monday behaved very badly. She had several opportunities to go away. - Henry Bailey, of Victoria-road, Battersea, roundabout and shooting-gallery proprietor, said prisoner had been in his employ as attendant at a shooting-gallery, and he discharged her recently at Faringdon, as she had too much to drink, and did not come to work at Wallingford. On Monday night she came to him a little aggravated, and "shoved him about," but he did not take much notice of it, and merely gave her into custody to keep her quiet. - P.C. Molden said Mr. Bailey told him to lock prisoner up for assaulting him. He took her to the County Police-station, where she was very impertinent. She was drunk and abusive. - Defendant again denied being drunk. - The Mayor said prisoner would be fined 5s. and 5s. 6d. costs for drunkenness, or in default seven days. - Prisoner elected to go to gaol, but Mr. Bailey paid the money, and she was accordingly discharged.	<i>The Abingdon Herald</i> , 11 October 1890, 5
