Cross-examined; She had heard the prisoner complain that her husband gave her no money. Her house was very badly furnished. The husband was sleeping at home just before the child died. The prisoner went to the public house to sell her fish. Mary Ann Stimpson saw the child der it was born and it was a "sic-baby." She saw it at different times, and it was in a filthy condition.
