1888	25 June	Abingdon, BRK	in magistrates court	Four dealers, named <i>William Pearce</i> , of Wallingford, <i>John Roberts</i> , of East Hendred, <i>James Bishop</i> , of Brightwell, and <i>Mansell Fletcher</i> , of East Hagbourne, were summoned for allowing their horses to stray in the parish of Long Wittenham, on the 15th inst. - P.C. Holloway proved the case, stating that he saw nine horses straying for half an hour across the Didcot-road. Several boys were playing together some distance off, and when they saw witness they ran towards the animals. - Pearce said his horses were taken out without his knowledge. The others pleaded that the animals had halters, and the the boys [<i>sic</i>] were ordered to prevent them from straying. - In the case of Bishop, against whom there was a long list of previous convictions at various courts, the Bench imposed the full penalty of five shillings for each of two horses, with 5s. 6d. costs. - Defendant : That's very cheap. - The others were fined 2s. 6d. for each horse, with costs.
