It appeared that the prisoners were in the "Royal Exchange" public-house, on Thursday, and that Police-constable Justice was called in, when the female prisoner was fighting with another woman ; the officer got them out into the street, and requested them to go home, but they refused to do so, and the male prisoner interfered, and very much abused the constable ; they were then taken into custody. As it proved to be the first time they had been before the Bench, they were discharged, with a severe caution. Amos Black, son of the above, was charged with having committed an unjustifiable assault on Sergeant Hinds, at the same time. Bridgman put down a sovereign on the table to pay for the keep, but Fox would not take it up. Witness was looking in a glass in the room, and saw Black take it up and put it in his pocket. He afterwards admitted having got it, but said he was taking care of it for Bridgman.
