1857	23 February	Middleton Cheney, NTH	in magistrates court, but falsely accused	At the petty sessions, at Middleton Cheney, on Monday last, William Booth, <i>alias</i> Colborne, of Paulerspury, described as a gipsy and chair-mender, was brought up in custody, under the following strange circumstances :- Samuel Martin, county police-constable said, "Inspector Evans told me he had see a warrant in the hands of parish-constable Morgan, of Kings Sutton, to apprehend the prisoner on a charge of arson, committed somewhere in the Brackley Division, and ordered me to apprehend the prisoner ; I did so on Saturday last, and he was then locked up at Towcester : this morning ; I received him again, with orders to bring him here." On enquiry of the different police-officers and others present, such a fire had never been heard of, but it was stated that Morgan had stated it to have been several ricks at Kings Sutton. It seems that he was travelling about the country obtaining warrants from magistrates against men for supposed offences ; and, by means thereof, obtaining money from different parties, besides entertainment at public-houses, stating himself to be in pursuit of an offender, and to have exhausted him money. A warrant is out against Morgan. Booth, <i>alias</i> William Smith, 21, gipsy, was indicted for having unlawfully and maliciously wounded Riley Smith with a knife with intent to do him grievous bodily harm, at Haxey, in this county, on the 15th August last. Mr. Kennedy prosecuted. It appeared that the prosecutor and all the parties concerned are gipsies, and in August they were encamped at a place called "America", near Haxey. The prisoner, the prosecutor, and a number of other gipsies were returning to the camp on the 15th August, and when about a mile from home the prisoner took up a little boy named William Smith, and carried him on his back. Eventually the prisoner fell down with him, and the prisoner and prosecutor disagreed, when it was said that the prisoner knocked Riley Smith down and ill-used him. After reaching the camp another disturbance arose, and upon the prosecutor going to see what was the matter prisoner, according to the prosecution, rushed upon him and stabbed him in nine different places, the result being that he was very ill for three weeks. The wounds altogether endangered the life of Riley Smith. Having obtained information from Dr. Stones, of Haxey, about the condition of Smith on the same night as the affray, P.c. John Linton went to the camp, and found the prisoner sitting by a fire. The officer told him that he wanted him, and prisoner said that if he could light his pipe he would go with him like a man. On the way to the lock-up, Linton charged the prisoner with having attempted to murder Riley Smith, and he made answer, "What I have done I have done in self-defence. If I had not used the knife, those three brothers would have murdered me." In consequence of the complaints that the prisoner made of ill-treatment at the hands of Riley Smith and his brothers he was examined, but no indications of any violence were to be found except on his lip. Prisoner, in his defence, maintained that he had been brutally ill-used by his companion gipsies, and he called a witness, named John Smith, who said that he was "uncle to all the Smith gipsies," and he spoke to Riley Smith and others ill-using prisoner, who, John Smith said, would have killed but for using a knife. - Prisoner's mother was also put into the witness-box, and she stated that the brothers Riley and Gehazi Smith, and also another brother, had three times tried to kill the prisoner. - His Lordship asked her why they all continued to live together, and witness answered that were all cousins and relatives. - His Lordship said that that was an extraordinary case, and certainly showed what very strange people there were living up and down in out of the way parts of Lincolnshire. He indeed was unable to give an exact account of the affair, for all the witnesses had talked so fast and in such a confused and ignorant manner that it was difficult to make out what the story was. He could not help thinking that they had been all more or less fighting together, and were drunk beside. He hardly thought the jury could convict of wounding with the intention of doing grievous bodily harm. Prisoner had obviously received great provocation, and had been very illused ; but it was for them to say whether he had acted entirely in self defence. All the gipsies had been making accusations one against the other of all sorts of crimes. - The jury found the prisoner guilty of unlawfully wounding, but strongly recommended him to the mercy of the Court, on the ground that he was subjected to great provocation. - There were two other indictments against the prisoner for similarly wounding Adam Smith and Elisha Mobbs, two other gipsies, but these were not proceeded with. - His Lordship said that he did not think the other gipsies were much better than the prisoner, but he must not use a knife in that way. Considering that he had been in prison nearly three months he must now be sentenced to six weeks' imprisonment with hard labour.
