





He was quite a link with past scenes and events of olden times, and no fair in the neighbourhood seemed complete without the presence of this wandering minstrel and we must say the people much enjoyed a dance or jig to his old-fashioned tunes. He was a typical country-fiddler, with no settled home, and he slept generally in a stable or other outbuilding of a village inn. On Saturday last he attended a fair held at the hamlet of Nuthampstead in Barkway parish, staying at the Woodman public house kept by Mr. George Martin. On Tuesday, when the heat was so great, he complained of pains in his head and apparently suffered from heat apoplexy. The next day the landlord found him lying in the stable much worse, so he sent for Dr. Downs, who arrived between 10 and 11 a.m. The doctor saw the deceased was seriously ill, as he had vomited blood, so he ordered his removal to the Buntingford Union. Arthur Barker, a labourer working for Mr. Martin, was bringing the poor man in a cart to the Union, and had got beyond Anstey, near to the village windmill, when the deceased suddenly called out "George." Barker, who was leading the horse, at once stopped and got into the cart, only to find the old fiddler was dead. An inquest was held on the body yesterday (Friday). Harry Boswell, as he was familiarly called, had a strangely chequered life, and his death under such grim circumstances must cause a general touch of pity [even] among those who knew nothing of the old fiddler, who, by the way, was sometimes employed for village gatherings by persons in good positions. So far as the gipsies themselves are physically concerned they can unquestionably claim kindred with the purest remnant of the gipsy race; the tawny and swarthy skins, the Grecian type of the noses of the men, the pearly lustre of the rather small but dark and piercing eyes of the women, with their beautiful raven locks hanging gracefully over their shoulders, are prominent characteristics of the gipsies of this encampment, and by which <i>pure</i> gipsies may be everywhere distinguished. Although we are not in a position at present to speak of the merits of their entertainment, we should imagine that their popularity in Cheltenham, and the success they met with there, together with the novel character of the whole affair, will attract large numbers to the field, as such another opportunity may not again be given to witness the native habits, customs, and performances of this singular but interesting race. Notwithstanding the threatening aspect of the weather many hundreds of persons of every grade visited the encampment, and great numbers were unable to obtain admission. What may have been the expectations of the visitors and the notions they entertained of the performances of the gipsies we know not, but it appears that a little disappointment was felt by them because they had heard and seen so little of the characteristics of gipsy life. We feel bound in justice to the gipsies to state that they are not wholly responsible for this. It appears the gipsies were advised, for various reasons, to lower the price of admission to sixpence each, which brought a much larger number than was anticipated, and caused an inconvenient crowding around the area allotted for the dancing, so that many persons could not obtain even a glimpse of the dancing party. And then the rain which came down not only interrupted the proceedings but considerably marred the pleasure of the evening. To avoid the rain a rush was made to the tents for shelter. A few were fortunate enough to obtain admission, but hundreds were compelled to remain outside, a fact which by no means added to their good humour or increased their appreciation of the gipsy encampment.
