



There were seven prisoners, all women, and they formed part of a tribe of gipsies, who are encamped in a field behind the Griffin Hotel, Lower Broughton, where they had been for some time A handsome well-dressed woman named Mary Parker, was described as the queen of the tribe; and the case against her was first heard. On Wednesday evening there was a gala at the encampment, and a large number of persons was attracted to the place. Dancing and fortune telling were the amusements, and as an admission fee of sixpence was charged, and a further fee of a shilling, if the oracles were consulted, there is reason to believe that the affair was profitable to the promoters. A char-woman, named Ellen M'Dermott paid a shilling to the queen to have her fortune told, and she now detailed the prophecy. The queen promised her a husband and a sum of money, and held out further inducements if the fee could be increased to half-acrown; but she had no more money. Sergeant Quick, of the Salford police force, came into the encampment just at that moment, and on learning that the queen had been telling fortunes he apprehended her In cross-examination by Mr. Cottingham, M'Dermott said that she asked to have her fortune told as a joke, and did not believe anything that the prisoner said to her Sylvester Boswell, a gipsy, was called for the defence, and he said there had been no fortune telling by any member of the tribe Mr. Trafford said he considered the case to be proved, and he committed the prisoner for seven days Mr. Cottingham said that the case would be taken either to the Queen's Bench or to the quarter sessions The case against Lavinia Boswell was next heard. He could not help thinking that they had been all more or less fighting together, and were drunk beside. He hardly thought the jury could convict of wounding with the intention of doing grievous bodily harm. Prisoner had obviously received great provocation, and had been very illused; but it was for them to say whether he had acted entirely in self defence. All the gipsies had been making accusations one against the other of all sorts of crimes The jury found the prisoner guilty of unlawfully wounding, but strongly recommended him to the mercy of the Court, on the ground that he was subjected to great provocation There were two other indictments against the prisoner for similarly wounding Adam Smith and Elisha Mobbs, two other gipsies, but these were not proceeded with His Lordship said that he did not think the other gipsies were much better than the prisoner, but he must not use a knife in that way. Considering that he had been in prison nearly three months he must now be sentenced to six weeks' imprisonment with hard labour. He wished to say that that was just the case in which it would be humane and kindly on the part of the gaol authorities to give particular attention to the prisoner, and tender him persuasively such advice that he would not return to those gipsy people.
