1867	16 May	Salford, LAN	in magistrates court	At the Salford Town Hall, on Thursday [16], a party of gipsies, who had been apprehended under the Vagrant Act, were brought before Mr. Trafford. There were seven prisoners, all women, and they formed part of a tribe of gipsies, who are encamped in a field behind the Griffin Hotel, Lower Broughton, where they had been for some time. - A handsome well-dressed woman named Mary Parker, was described as the queen of the tribe ; and the case against her was first heard. On Wednesday evening there was a gala at the encampment, and a large number of persons was attracted to the place. Dancing and fortune telling were the amusements, and as an admission fee of sixpence was charged, and a further fee of a shilling, if the oracles were consulted, there is reason to believe that the affair was profitable to the promoters. A char-woman, named Ellen M'Dermott paid a shilling to the queen to have her fortune told, and she now detailed the prophecy. The queen promised her a husband and a sum of money, and held out further inducements if the fee could be increased to half-a-crown ; but she had no more money. Sergeant Quick, of the Salford police force, came into the encampment just at that moment, and on learning that the queen had been telling fortunes he apprehended her. - In cross-examination by Mr. Cottingham, M'Dermott said that she asked to have her fortune told as a joke, and did not believe anything that the prisoner said to her. - Sylvester Boswell, a gipsy, was called for the defence, and he said there had been no fortune telling by any member of the tribe. - Mr. Trafford said he considered the case to be proved, and he committed the prisoner for seven days. - Mr. Cottingham said that the case would be taken either to the Queen's Bench or to the quarter sessions. - The case against Lavinia Boswell was next heard. In this case it was admitted that Sergeant Quick had sent a factory hand, named Ellen Walworth, to the gala, and that she had her fortune told by the prisoner, in order that she might appear as a witness. - The witness said, "The prisoner crossed my hand with a shilling which I had paid to her, and then shut it up in my hand, and told me to wish. - (Laughter.) When she opened my hand she said, "You have not wished for money, but for happiness, and you will have more of it than you expect. However high you have been you will be higher yet. You will have a very good summer. You will have three children." After hearing this witness said she thought it was time to be going. Sergeant Quick apprehended Boswell just as the prophecy was finished. - Mr. Cottingham said that the conduct of the police had been disgraceful. Gipsies were present and told fortunes on every racecourse ; and he hoped the Court would not convict under an obsolete piece of legislation which was a relic of the barbarous feelings of a former age. - Mr. Trafford convicted the prisoner, and sentenced her to seven days' imprisonment. - The other five women were discharged, as it was thought that a sufficient example had been made. Eventually the prisoner fell down with him, and the prisoner and prosecutor disagreed, when it was said that the prisoner knocked Riley Smith down and ill-used him. After reaching the camp another disturbance arose, and upon the prosecutor going to see what was the matter prisoner, according to the prosecution, rushed upon him and stabbed him in nine different places, the result being that he was very ill for three weeks. The wounds altogether endangered the life of Riley Smith. Having obtained information from Dr. Stones, of Haxey, about the condition of Smith on the same night as the affray, P.c. John Linton went to the camp, and found the prisoner sitting by a fire. The officer told him that he wanted him, and prisoner said that if he could light his pipe he would go with him like a man. On the way to the lock-up, Linton charged the prisoner with having attempted to murder Riley Smith, and he made answer, "What I have done I have done in self-defence. If I had not used the knife, those three brothers would have murdered me." In consequence of the complaints that the prisoner made of ill-treatment at the hands of Riley Smith and his brothers he was examined, but no indications of any violence were to be found except on his lip.</p> <p>Prisoner, in his defence, maintained that he had been brutally ill-used by his companion gipsies, and he called a witness, named John Smith, who said that he was "uncle to all the Smith gipsies," and he spoke to Riley Smith and others ill-using prisoner, who, John Smith said, would have killed but for using a knife. - Prisoner's mother was also put into the witness-box, and she stated that the brothers Riley and Gehazi Smith, and also another brother, had three times tried to kill the prisoner. - His Lordship asked her why they all continued to live together, and witness answered that were all cousins and relatives. - His Lordship said that that was an extraordinary case, and certainly showed what very strange people there were living up and down in out of the way parts of Lincolnshire.
