Police-constable George Shepherd, examined : On the 24th September I went with prisoner into a field belonging to Mr. Pickett. He pointed the gun out to me. It was at the side of the hedge, partly in the hedge and partly in the ditch. He said he did not put it there himself, but he was with the man who did put it there. At the request of the prisoner, Mr. Hemmings was recalled, and the prisoner asked him if he did not tell him that if he (prisoner) told him about the gun, he would not prosecute him. Mr. Hemmings : That was before the police apprehended you. Prisoner : No such thing ; it was when I was at the police station. I never took the gun myself, and never went up stairs. I sat at the bottom of the stairs. Police-superintendent Hawkes examined : On the 23rd of September I was at Stevenage fair. Mr. Hemmings came to me and said he had lost a gun, and should give Brinkley into custody for stealing it. I went with him and found Brinkley, who denied all knowledge of it. I took him into custody. The next morning Brinkley said that he would show us where the gun was, but that he did not steal it himself. There was no promise made in my presence about not prosecuting the prisoner. The DEPUTY-CHAIRMAN summed up the case, observing that it was not necessary that the prisoner should be the person who took the gun. He was equally guilty if he were in the house at the time, and in co-operation with the actual thief.
