Sharpley), into the circumstances of the death of Mrs. Lucy Brown (103), widow, of Finsbury-street, Alford, which occurred on the previous Wednesday as the result of an accident at the deceased's house. Mrs. Wilhelmina Wilde, daughter of deceased, said that about eight o'clock on Wednesday evening, March 22nd, she went into the house and found her mother lying between the window and the table. Her clothes were in flames. Deceased said, "I am burning alive." With the aid of Mr. Leverton she got the fire out as best she could. William Leverton, tailor, said Mrs. Wilde called him to the house, saying, "Come, granny's afire." Witness went, and found Mrs. Brown lying across the floor in flames. Witness picked up the hearthrug, and threw it on her. Dr. T. E. Sandall, Alford, said he found deceased's hands very badly burnt, and also her chest and legs. She lived until Wednesday night, and, after much suffering, died from the shock. The jury returned a verdict in accordance with the medical evidence.
