1889	29 October	Oxford, OXF	in magistrates court	<i>James Brown</i> , hawker, was charged with stealing 13s. 2d., the moneys of Fred. Stean Baker, from Thomas Mitchell, in High-street, St. Thomas', on Saturday afternoon last. - Thomas Mitchell, in the employ of the prosecutor, stated that he was delivering bread in High-street, St. Thomas', about half-past four on Saturday afternoon last, when a mishap occurred to his cart, and he was thrown out on to the ground. His money bag, which was across his shoulder capsized, and the money fell out. There were several persons about, and some of the money was picked up and returned to him. On going back to the shop he counted the money in the bag, and found he was about 14s. short of the amount he had received from his customers. A short time afterwards prisoner was taken into custody. - William Green, Penson's-gardens, foreman for Mr. Round Green, coal merchant, deposed that on Saturday afternoon he was in St. Thomas', and saw Mitchell and a crowd of people. There was a lot of money lying about the street, some of which was picked up by the prisoner, who had silver in one hand and copper in the other. The silver consisted chiefly of half-crowns and two-shilling pieces. Prisoner handed the copper to witness, and put the silver into his trousers' pocket. He asked the accused to give up the money that belonged to the baker, and he said, "It's all right, mate," at the same time winking at him. Witness again demanded the money, which he said he intended giving to the last witness. Brown then said he had no money but what belonged to himself, and so witness detained him till a constable came up, and then gave him into custody. - Cross-examined. He saw the prisoner tumble down on the money. - Prisoner was then formally charged and pleaded guilty. - P.C. Barratt said that 16s. 6d. in silver and 7½d. in bronze were found in prisoner's pocket when searched at the police-station. When given into witness' custody prisoner persisted in saying he ought to have had two pounds in his pocket. On account of the large crowd, prisoner had no opportunity of running away with the money. - The Mayor said the magistrates considered it was a very cowardly act of the prisoner's, who had seen the baker thrown out of his cart, and then used the opportunity of picking up the money, which he put into his pocket.
