The previous Monday, the 12th July, he was at Marcham Feast, when the defendant came down the village street and commenced to abuse him respecting the ground on which his stall stood. Defendant said he would have the ground or "rip us up." Jabez Buckland struck his brother in the left eye. His wife, the other defendant, also hit his brother, who was endeavouring to get away. Defendant said he would follow them 100 miles but what he would kill them. - Cross-examined, he said Mrs. Buckland hit his brother when her husband was striking him. He went for the policeman when he saw his brother struck. Alice Shaw also gave evidence as to the removal of the stall and the language used. She saw Jabez Buckland strike her brother in the eye. She also saw Mrs. Buckland strike her brother. Jabez Buckland then gave his version of the affair, which took place in the morning between 10 and 11 o'clock. He said he went to Shaw and told him not to put his stall up on their ground. Noah Shaw took off his coat. There was a "sparring" between them. Noah Shaw went up to Buckland's roundabouts, picked up a piece of wood, and knocked him down. Amy Shaw said defendant struck her with his fist. Abraham Buckland, brother of the defendant Buckland, said he saw the two "sparring." Shaw picked up a piece of wood on the roundabouts and struck his brother. Other evidence having been given. P.C. Heater, stationed at Marcham, said there was a general disturbance amongst the van people attending the Feast, which appeared to have originated over the ground. He advised both parties to take out a summons. Her daughter "was not able to fight." - Complainant said she could fight and was as big a woman as she (complainant) was. She would swear the men struck her. - After some wrangling between the elder <i>Buckland</i> and <i>Duckett</i> , in which the former told complainant she should "never wrong her conscience," and that her (complainant's) evidence was a "wrong foundation" the Bench decided to hear another case of assault arising out of the same disturbance. - <i>Rosina Gloucester</i> was charged with assaulting <i>Susan Loveridge</i> , on the 19th inst. - Complainant said that on the Monday in question defendant, without the least provocation, struck her in the face. - <i>Mr. Robinson</i> : Is it the custom then amongst you hawkers, without saying anything, to strike one another in the face, when you meet? - Defendant, who said it was a fight, and that they both struck one another, called her uncle, <i>Abraham Buckland</i> , who stated that as he was in front of his van he saw some fighting going on about sixty yards off, and he ran up and saw it was "the girls" fighting. The last time she saw the watch was on Wednesday. - <i>Jacob Amberton</i> , nine years of age, said he had the watch and chain produced given to him in the cricketing meadow by <i>Frank Whitehead</i> on Thursday. He gave him some sweets for it, and did not ask where he got it from. Witness's little brother had the watch first. Witness afterwards sold the watch to his brother <i>William</i> for a penny. - <i>William Amberton</i> , a lad, deposed that on Thursday afternoon he gave his brother a penny for the watch, and afterwards to <i>Abraham Buckland</i> for three pence and a cocoa-nut. Prisoner asked him to see the watch, and he did so. He told witness it was no "count of," and only fit to "knock up, to make crackers." - Cross-examined : It was the feast at Sutton that day. I did not ask anyone else to buy the watch. I did not hear another call out "Here's a boy who wants to sell a watch for threepence." The transaction was done openly on the green. <i>P.C. Webb</i> said prosecutor and his wife gave information to him on Saturday evening, and he went to <i>Ilsley</i> , and took prisoner into custody. He asked prisoner where the watch was which he had bought of a boy at Sutton, and he replied that his son <i>William</i> had it. The son, who was wearing the watch, gave it up at once. - By <i>Mr. Dudley</i> : He did not attempt to conceal it. - <i>Mr. Dudley</i> contended that there was no ground for supposing that <i>Buckland</i> knew the watch was stolen. - The Bench expressed their opinion that it was a case of strong suspicion, but they did not think the evidence was sufficient to convict.
