Another boy then came up with the three prisoners, and the four went up Kimbrose-alley. Witness afterwards told a cabman of what he had seen, and subsequently identified the prisoners at the Police-station. - George Albert Morgan stated that he was with the prisoners most of the day. They all went down Southgate-street together and stood outside Mr. Williams' shop for some two or three minutes, when Boon said he would go in and get a cake. Witness then went down the street, and was followed by Buckland and his brother. Soon afterwards Boon came running up to them with a cash-box under his coat. They went down the Kimbrose, where Boon opened the box. Subsequently the four of them went round the back of the Docks into a stone-yard. The cash-box contained one sovereign, two half-sovereigns, some silver, and copper. The money was counted and divided.
