1859	early March	Oxford, OXF	at the assizes	At the Oxford assizes Phœbe Bunce, a gipsy woman, surrendered to take her trial upon a charge of stealing 10l. 9s. 4d. and various articles, the property of John Prior, at Witney. It appeared that on the 12th of January last the prisoner went to the house of the prosecutor, who was a butcher at Witney. The prosecutor was out at the time, but the prisoner saw his wife, and addressed her, saying, "Mrs. Prior, you are looking very ill. I have got something to tell you. There is some property left for you that you have been cheated out of, and I can get it for you." Mrs. Prior had, in fact, been unwell for some time, and had expected her uncle to leave her some money, but he had died suddenly without carrying out his intention, so far as she was aware. The prisoner then followed up her attack by saying that she had got a book, and she could raise the spirits and lay them if Mrs. Prior would put half-a-crown on a certain spot in the book which she pointed out. Mrs. Prior said to the prisoner that she had heard of such things, and was induced to put some money in the book. The prisoner went away and returned the next day, and said she had been working all night, and that her husband's money would not do, and she must have sovereigns. She said a dog had brought a letter in his mouth to her van ; and she then required her to give her all the money she had got, and promised she would bring it back the next Monday, and also the sum of 170l., which she said belonged to her. On these representations the poor dupe gave her all the money	<i>Jackson's Oxford Journal</i> , 10 March 1859, 3

				<p>she could get, amounting to 10l. 2s. 4d. Mrs. Prior, who appeared to be a very nervous woman, said she was so frightened at what the prisoner told her, that she felt she must go and get the money she wanted, and that she let her have it because she believed from what she said she could do her good or evil, and was so afraid of her. When Mrs. Prior gave the prisoner the money, she required a shift to wrap the money up in, and also Mrs. Prior's shawl. The prisoner then wanted a cloth to fasten it all up in, saying she must bury it. This was given, and also Mrs. Prior's gold wedding-ring, a silver thimble, a brass ring, and five old silver coins, the prisoner saying she must have everything Mrs. Prior had got that was valuable. All these things were given to the prisoner on her promise to bring them all back on the Monday, together with the 170l., and to have a cup of tea. The prisoner was to have 5l. for her trouble. It is unnecessary to state that she never returned, and was taken into custody in February, with Mrs. Prior's shawl upon her.</p> <p>The jury, without hesitation, found the prisoner guilty, and his lordship sentenced her to eight calendar months' imprisonment, with hard labour.</p>
