Sherrington, a keeper to the Duke of Grafton, said that on the day in question he was at home at a quarter to ten in the morning. He saw five gipsies go past, and they began searching the fences. He followed them, and he saw them go to a pheasant's nest, and picked up stones and threw at the bird. When it rose they tried to knock it down with a stick, but it got away. They went on searching again, and he saw them take out several eggs and break one. He did not call for assistance until they stoned another pheasant off the nest. He then went to Hall Farm, and in company with Mr. Hall, the agent and another, they went in the direction of Euston Grove, and there came up with the four defendants. Witness searched one and found nothing upon him, but ten pheasants' eggs were found upon one of the others.
