1824	22 December	not known, SSX	at the Assizes	<i>George Lee and Samuel Clarke</i> were indicted for assaulting and robbing Henry Weston, at Salehurst, on the 9th October. Mr. MARSHALL conducted the prosecution, and Mr. DOWLING the defence. It appeared that the prisoners were of the gipsy tribe. On the 9th of October the prosecutor was going from Burwash to Salehurst on business. In his way he was attacked by the prisoners in a wood, one of whom struck him a blow on the head with a bludgeon, which brought him senseless to the ground. Whilst he remained senseless they robbed him of about 15s. in money. In three days afterwards he saw the prisoners at their camp, near Bourne, and immediately recognised them. He now swore positively to their identity. An alibi was set up for both prisoners. There was a good deal of contradiction between the witnesses, and in some particulars their evidence was directly at variance. 1866	23 June	Godmanchester, CAM	in magistrates court	Charles Clark, traveller, was brought up on the information of Henry Bush, itinerant hatter, charged with unlawfully and wilfully assaulting and beating him at William Castle's lodging house, on the 21st and 22nd instant. Defendant said he was not guilty of the charge. From the evidence of complainant it seems that on the first day named a party of travellers were at the lodging house above referred to, and the landlord made some remark as to whether complainant's child was quiet, and his wife replied that the child had been cross lately on account of its teeth. Other remarks were made by those present, and complainant's wife said that as the defendant had no children of his own, he did not know the care of them. Some disagreeable language followed, and defendant's wife told the wife of complainant that she would pull her head off, and complainant was taking the child away when defendant placed his arm round her neck, struck him in the face, and caused him to have a black eye. When he had released himself, he told him he should put him "somewhere." Mary Ann Wortley, a travelling woman, gave evidence and refuted the major portion of complainant's statement. She saw complainant with a poker, and the accused attempted to dispossess him of it, and in doing so it caught complainant on the eye, which caused it to blacken. - The MAYOR : You suppose it was done accidentally? - Witness: I do, Sir: It was, there were no blows struck. - Complainant: That is false. - Witness further stated that complainant's wife threw the boiling contents of her (witness') tea-pot over defendant's wife, and scalded her. - The accused told the Bench that it was a good thing he took the poker from the complainant, as he believed he meant to murder him. - The MAYOR intimated to the parties that the Bench considered that they could not enter into their case; in fact, they were both guilty: they used bad language to each other, and that was the cause of something else, and they (the Bench) considered it their duty to dismiss the case.
