1851	30 April	Yorks, YKS	in magistrates court as complainant	On Wednesday last, at the Guildhall, before the Lord Mayor, Elizabeth Jackson, of Morpeth, and Wm. Todd, of this city, labourer, were charged, the former with having stolen a silk pocket handkerchief, the property of Thos. Claydon, hawker, and the latter with having received the same. The previous afternoon, the prosecutor met the female prisoner on Ouse bridge, and he proceeded with her to the Bloomsbury public-house, Swinegate, where they had a shillingsworth of spirits in a sitting-room. They went away together, when Claydon discovering he had lost his handkerchief, accused his colleague of having stolen it. She denied the charge, saying it would probably be in the room, to which they repaired, but it was not there to be found. Prosecutor then went to the police station, and, during his absence, the female threw the handkerchief on to the fire in the kitchen, whereupon Todd snatched it from the flames, but it was partly burnt. His lordship said there could be no case against the male prisoner, and as for the female, it appeared that she and the prosecutor were in liquor at the time, and she might have taken the article up without a felonious intent. He therefore discharged her, and cautioned the landlady as to the manner in which the house was conducted.	<i>The York Herald, and General Advertiser, 10 May 1851, 6</i>
