The officer had only just lately been able to serve the summons on the defendant. The case was clearly proved by Harwood, and that defendant had such a large fire that he had some difficulty to get his horse by. Defendant did not appear. Convicted ; fine 1l. 10s., costs 10s., or one month. CAUTION TO GYPSIES. - Job Loveridge, a travelling dealer and tinker, who gave his address as Stoke Lyne, although he resided there no oftener than he did in other places, was, by Superintendent Howard, charged with having, on the 12th of December last, at the parish of Rousham, encamped by the side of the turnpike road leading from Deddington to Oxford, whereby he had rendered himself liable to a fine of £2.
