He replied that he was no fighting man, whereupon Stanley struck him. James Stanley then struck him, and pulled him back. His father caught him by the hair, and the other defendant also struck him, and gave him a black eye. 				Saturday night been at a public-house at Kingston, and that he had there arranged to fight with one of the defendants at Hilsea. - Sylvester Lee corroborated the complainant's evidence as to two of the Stanleys. The others, he said, looked on. - In cross-examination, the witness said he was brother-in-law of the complainant. Deacon had a stick in his hand at the time; but he did not strike the men. - Mr. Cousins: Was there a fight between Deacon and these men? - The witness, after a great deal of hesitating, said there was not. Mr. Stigant: What were you hesitating about? If there were no fight, why did you hesitate? I think you may stand down. - The magistrates thought there was no evidence against John Stanley the elder and James Stanley the elder; and the informations against them were therefore dismissed. - The defence raised by Mr. Cousins for the others was that on the Saturday night there was an agreement to fight at Hilsea between Deacon and young Stanley; that Deacon went there for the express purpose of fighting; that when the parties met on the following day a fight took place, and that the alleged assault by the other men never took place. - Mary Pearce was called for the defence, and she swore that on Saturday night she heard Deacon and Stanley, jun., agree, at a public-house at Kingston, to fight on the following morning. - The magistrates dismissed the informations against the whole of the defendants.
