1889	April	Eastbourne, SSX		A remarkable elopement case was investigated on Friday by the Eastbourne magistrates. A wood merchant named Smith, of St. Anthony, Tower Hill, Eastbourne, charged a young gipsy, named Andrew Dighton, with unlawfully eloping with his daughter, Caroline Smith. - Mr. Smith stated that his daughter was under 18 years of age, and had manifested a strange passion for the young gipsy, who is a good-looking youth about her own age. Mrs. Smith sent her daughter out shopping, but instead of going the errands she went to the gipsy and urged him to elope with her from Eastbourne. Dighton strongly refused, but Caroline Smith pleaded so passionately with her gipsy lover that he was forced to submit, and they left Eastbourne secretly, taking with them a small tent. They could not pitch the tent the first night, so they sought shelter under a hedge. They tramped day after day, and camped out at night in the Sussex lanes. The runaways passed on to Brighton, Uckfield, Tunbridge Wells, and Woolwich, followed by their father and the police ; but it was not until the girl was found living with Dighton in the tent on Plumstead Marshes that Detective Goldsack caught up with them. There Miss Smith and her paramour protested strongly against returning to Eastbourne, and Dighton was arrested. - The magistrate discharged the gipsy, who pleaded that the girl had urged the elopement against his will, and that he did not know that she was under 18. Miss Smith did not allow her adventures to rest even with the termination of the case, for a scene in the streets followed the discharge of the gipsy.
