1866	28 May	Saffron Walden, ESS	Moses charged in magistrates court but did not appear	<i>Moses Shaw and James Shaw</i> , of Stotfold, Beds, and <i>Walter Smith</i> , of Wansted, traveller, were summoned for unlawfully encamping on the highway called Cole End-road, in the parish of Wimbush, on the 12th May. - The defendants did not appear, but the wife of Moses Shaw came up for her husband. - P.c.
