1879	25 September	Cambridge, CAM	in magistrates court	On Thursday, the 18th instant, a gipsy woman, rejoicing in the unfeminine name of Leviathan Thorp (the wife of a travelling gipsy) called at the residence of Mrs. James, of Market-street, having buttons to sell. Two servant girls "answered" the door-bell, and some small articles being purchased, Leviathan asked Hannah Chapman, who, although only "sweet seventeen," holds the dignified position of cook, whether she		<i>The Cambridge Independent Press</i> , 27 September 1879, 7

				would like to have her fortune told : Hannah thought she should, and gave her fellow servant (about the same age) "the straight tip" to leave her while Leviathan unveiled the future, for her special edification. The cook, being now at the mercy of Leviathan, the usual performance, "in that case made and provided" proceeded. Little Cookey was requested to produce a piece of gold, which she did, in the shape of a sovereign, with which she crossed the Leviathan's delicate hand : then a pack of cards was produced, representing a small planetary system, on which the gold was placed. Then followed the usual hocus-pocus business. The sovereign was placed in a piece of paper ; then, apparently another piece ; and finally in a third piece. Then a parcel resembling the paper, with a coin in it, was returned to the girl ; but in this legerdemain the cook's goose was cooked. The Leviathan solemnly exclaimed "put the parcel under your pillow, and you will dream of a handsome young man ; he will be your husband ; but if you examine the parcel before the end of the week the charm will be broken. Swear that you will not open the paper till seven days have expired." Then the Leviathan administered the following oath ; "I swear, so help me God, that I will not open the parcel for a week." After this, she was told that after the expiration of seven days she would find £1 10s. instead of a sovereign. Thereupon the Leviathan took her departure. Now, when Hannah Chapman informed her fellow servant, Sarah Adams, of the result of the interview, she was incredulous ; and strongly urged her to open the mysterious parcel, and Hannah did so, and lo and behold ! her golden sovereign had been metamorphosed into a paltry farthing. Hannah rushed to the Police Office, and gave information of what had transpired. Within a couple of hours, Sergeant Dockerill secured Leviathan Thorp, and Hannah's sovereign was found wrapped in a piece of paper. The prisoner was taken before James Cropley, Esq., and remanded till Thursday, the 25th instant, bail being taken for appearance, the amount £30, being deposited in the hands of Mr. Evans, clerk to the magistrates. On Thursday there was a crowded room to hear the case. The depositions being read, Mr. Naylor, who appeared for the prisoner, advised her to plead guilty. He stated that she had four children, and in a few months another little Leviathan might be expected. This was the first charge that had ever been brought against her, and he expressed the hope that the Bench would deal leniently with her, thereby showing a manly compassion upon her, in her situation ; no injury had been done ; the girl had got her sovereign back again ; and if a certain amount of wickedness had been shown on the one hand ; at any rate great folly had been displayed on the other. The Bench considered a long time as to whether to commit the prisoner for trial, or to deal with the case summarily ; eventually it was decided to give her 6 month's hard labour.

1886	12 November	Mildenhall, SFK	Ambrose in magistrates court	Ambrose Thorpe, hawker, was summoned, for assaulting William Mortlock, on November 11th, at Barton Mills. - Mr. Bendall defended. - Complainant said on the 11th inst. he was at Barton Mills, near the four cross roads, and saw defendant there with his vans ; he ordered him to go away in two hours. On going further up the road he saw some horses on what is called the "Butt Heath." - Complainant got down from his cart and took the halter off one of the horses and was leading it on the road, when one of the party came up, slipped the halter off, and drove the horses on, and defendant came up behind and struck him a blow with a whip stick. Complainant left his cart on the road in charge on a man named Leeks. - Cross-examined : I did not hit defendant on the wrist. I struck him twice in self defence. 				did not whip them. Defendant did not come and speak to me. There were seven horses that had been trespassing. I was authorised by Mr. Betts to remove any horses. - - Mr. Shaw, surgeon, said yesterday complainant came to him and found he had a contused wound on his head. The bone was not exposed nor the scalp injured. - William Leeks stated that on the 11th, about a quarter past one, he was in company with Mortlock. Some vans stood at Barton corner, and complainant ordered them away. A little further up the road some horses were straying on the heath. Mortlock got out of the cart and took hold of the halter of one, and was leading it on the road when one of the Thorpes came up, knocked the halter off, and defendant struck Mortlock a blow on the head with a whip-stick. - Cross-examined : The stick had a bone handle and a brass ferule. Defendant struck complainant with the butt-end. Mortlock did not take his whip. Thorpe and complainant were not struggling together. Mortlock was standing still and defendant slipped behind and struck him. Mortlock did not strike the horses. I did not see Mortlock strike the man. - Mr. Bendall maintained that there was a free fight between the party, brought about by Mortlock beating the defendant's horses, and the question for the bench was whether Mortlock or defendant was the aggressor. - Jas. Thorpe stated he was a licensed hawker, and defendant was his nephew. He saw Mortlock at the Barton Cross Roads. He had vans on the road ; the horses were grazing in the parish pits, between the Thetford and Bury roads, fifty or sixty yards from the vans ; their feet were tied. He and his father had leave to put them there from Mortlock, sen. - Mortlock, sen., being in court, said he told witness that if he was going to stop there he must keep his horses from straying. - Thorpe's evidence continued : Witness saw complainant come in a trap with another man. Mortlock told them to be gone in two hours. They then drove on ; when they came to the horses Mortlock got out of his cart and commenced beating the horses. Witness went up, and slipped the halter off his father's horse, which Mortlock had hold of, and his nephew came up and laid hold of the end of the halter, upon which Mortlock struck him across the wrist. A scimmage then ensued, in which complainant received a blow. Mortlock appeared the worse for drink. - James Thorpe, sen., gave similar evidence. - The bench convicted defendant of the assault, and fined him, with costs, 15s. 6d.

He tried to catch hold of Hart, when that prisoner got away, and Hagan handed him a brick, with which he struck witness in the face, injuring him in such a manner as to necessitate his going to the General Hospital for the purpose of having his wounds dressed. Witness then drew his staff, and struck one of the prisoners with it, but the staff was taken from him and broken. He blew his whistle, and Police-constable Garfield came to his assistance. The whole of the prisoners then commenced to stone the constables, and continued to do so for some time, Cotter supplying them with stones. Evidence was given in support of this statement ; and the Bench sentenced Draper and Flewett to six weeks' imprisonment with hard labour. The evidence revealed an astonishing amount of credulity on the part of the prosecutrix - a woman aged 43, and of good position - and of her housekeeper, Jessie Allen. The latter first met the prisoner on Mitcham Common, had her fortune told, and gave her permission to come to her mistress's house. She then gave the gipsy 12s and a ring, on her assertion that she could "tell the future," and that she would "do her (Allen) some good." She also promised to get her a husband in three months. The prisoner was subsequently interviewed by the mistress, to whom she also promised to "do some good." She obtained £3 to "put on the wheel of fate," and on a second visit persuaded her dupe to pay £8 more, because "the £3 wasn't enough to make the wheel go round." At a third interview Mrs. Collins gave her some rings and a cheque, and afterwards 10s to get the rings back.
