Docker, Esq., respecting the death of Melissa Davis, five weeks old, daughter of Elizabeth Davis and Charles Butler, an itinerant scissor grinder. It appeared that on Tuesday, the 14th inst., the parties had been drinking the greater part of the day, and being inebriated they lay down for the night in a narrow lane a short distance from the village, instead of going to their tent a few miles away. Between three and four o'clock in the morning, the mother, who had wrapped the child in the skirts of her clothing, discovered that it was dead or dying, and immediately took it to Dr. Fitch, who pronounced it dead. From the evidence of Dr. Fitch. it was clearly shown that the woman, in her unconscious state must have rolled upon the child, as there were no marks of violence except a discolouration on the right side of the child, next to the woman. Mr. Lamb (landlord) spoke of the scene at his house, and said he saw the man dragging complainant about by the hair of the head. - The husband of complainant was called. - Complainant was in the Infirmary for several days in consequence of the injuries she had received. - The Bench said no doubt a most disgraceful scene had occurred, which was aggravated by the fact that the parties were connected by family ties. Five gipsies, Riley Beldam, fifty ; Thomas Beldam, twenty-one ; Arthur Fletcher, twenty-two ; Sidney Hughes, twenty-two ; and Henry Davis, twenty-six, were charged with resisting Police-sergeant, 46 X, in the execution of his duty. Mr. Pierron, solicitor, defended. Several gipsies who have been a source of annoyance to the authorities of Willesden cannot be induced to leave a large encampment at Kensal Rise, near the Sports Ground. The evidence showed that they had a number of horses which they turned into anyone's fields to graze. On Saturday evening the owner of one field turned fourteen of their horses out on the highway, where some policemen, who had been prepared for what would happen, secured them with lassoes and halters, and took them to some stabling at the rear of a public-house in Harrow Road, which was used as a pound. During the night an entry was forced and the horses removed. At the gipsy encampment fourteen of the horses in the camp were identified. Beldom immediately said something in the Romany language, and the prisoners jumped up, flew onto the backs of horses, formed a circle, narrowing it until they had possession of the fourteen horses. Beldom obstructed the police all he could, and the other four attempted to ride over them. An exciting scene ensued, during which Mr. Pinkham, a member of the bench, arrived.
