1887	23 August	Oxford, OXF	in magistrates court	<i>John Ellis, hawker, no home, was charged with being drunk and disorderly in Paradise-street, at 11.45 p.m. on Saturday, also with using obscene language in Queen-street and other streets on the way to the station. - Pleaded not guilty. - P.C. Dixon said the prisoner was drunk and lying asleep under a garden wall in Paradise-street. He awoke him and asked him to go home. The prisoner then commenced using filthy language. He took him into custody, and on the way to the station, whither they were obliged to carry him, he was very violent and used obscene language. At the station he kicked and bit them, and spat in their faces. - Prisoner said he was very sorry ; he had not seen a bed since Good Friday. - There were 14 previous convictions, and prisoner was now sentenced to one month's hard labour.</i>	<i>The Abingdon Herald, 27 August 1887, 7</i>

1888	30 October	Oxford, OXF	in magistrates court	<i>John Ellis, no home, hawker, was charged with being drunk and disorderly in the meat market, on Saturday last, and further with using obscene language at the police-station. - He pleaded not guilty. - P.C. Brooks said that he saw the prisoner in the market with a crowd of people round him. He was drunk and abusive and refused to go away. Witness eventually took him to the police-station, where he used most filthy language and was very violent. - Prisoner, who had been convicted on eighteen previous occasions at this court, complained of lads interfering with him in the market, whenever he passed through. - The Mayor said it was a difficult thing to know what to do with the prisoner, who had been before the court nineteen times. It seemed, however, to make no difference to him what punishment was inflicted. He was constantly appearing in that court. The magistrates thought he was to be pitied, because they knew that boys and men did continually tease him. But that did not justify him in getting drunk.
