They then sent their dogs into some swedes close by the lodge, and put up a hare, and the dogs coursed it into the road, where they killed it. Witness went up to the vans and stopped them.</p> <p>William , carter to the Rev. H. R. Du Pre, saw the four dogs beating the field belonging to his master. Could not recognise the defendants, and did not see the hare killed.</p> <p>The Bench said they were liable to a fine of £5, they would have to pay £2 1s. 8d. each, or one month's imprisonment.
