He waited outside the gates until they were opened from the inside and then went in and in five minutes he came out carrying a sack of something. Witness followed him down the street and overtook him, and examined the sack and found it contained about 18lbs. of good hay. Defendant said he hoped witness would say nothing about it. Witness afterwards saw Gage in Canon Kewley's study, and heard him say if Canon Kewley would forgive him he would leave the town. Canon Kewley said he would not then decide what course he should follow. Witness then went to Marsden and he confessed to Gage and himself having filled the sack from a truss which he pointed out in the stables. Two hours afterwards witness heard Marsden tell Canon Kewley in his study that he knew he had done wrong and hoped he would forgive him. His Lordship: That is to say, you stole your master's hay and gave it to him? Witness: Yes, sir, I have since been convicted of the offence. Prisoner: If he gave me anything more than a little rough stuff, I must leave it to your Honour. His Lordship (to the witness): Was it rough stuff? Witness: It was a little rough, but it was out of the truss. His Lordship: Good eatable hay, I suppose? Witness: Yes, the horses would have eaten it. The prisoner is a fishmonger, and keeps a pony. Sergeant Hammond deposed to watching the prisoner go to Canon Kewley's gate with an empty bag and come away with it full. Witness told him to take it to the police-station, and on examining it there found it contained 18lbs. of good, sweet hay. Prisoner asked him not to say anything to Canon Kewley about it; and on the following day prisoner said to Canon Kewley, "I own I have done wrong, but if you will be kind enough not to prosecute I will leave the town and take my family with me." The coachman Marsden was fined by the magistrates. His Lordship expressed astonishment that he had got off with a fine. Witness said that owing to Canon Kewley's intervention the magistrates treated it as case of unlawful possession, and inflicted a fine, instead of sending him to prison. Prisoner (who had evidently been drinking) said in defence that he only asked Marsden for a little rough stuff, and he did not know but what it was rough stuff, "but if it was stolen he must give in." The jury found him guilty, and it was stated that he was summarily convicted for felony at Stevenage in 1881.
