Geo. Bence, of Bishopston. The facts of this case are rather singular. Last April, a domestic servant of the rev. prosecutor, named Elizabeth Cavell, was charged with stealing, among other articles, four silver tea-spoons. The girl declared she had lent the spoons to a gipsy woman, for the purpose of "ruling her planet," but the woman disappeared. This tale was hardly credited, and Cavell was convicted and sentenced to imprisonment. The police made fruitless endeavours to discover the gipsy woman, and the incident was almost forgotten; but last Thursday week the two Greens were observed by a policeman to enter a pawnshop in the town of Coventry, and subsequent inquiry led to their apprehension and that of the prisoner Smith, who was found a few miles out of Coventry in charge of a van in which the trio journeyed from town to town. In the possession of the prisoners was found, besides the spoons in question and a silver fork, a number of articles of wearing-apparel and other things, from a child's muslin robe to a pair of chintz window-curtains, all of which are supposed to have been obtained from servant-girls under pretense of telling fortunes. 





				On Monday last an occurrence of a somewhat rare character (at least in this neighbourhood) took place, namely, a gipsy marriage, according to the rites of the Church of England. The event created an immense amount of excitement in this village, and drew together a great number of people from Thame and the surrounding parishes to witness the ceremony, which took place in the Parish Church. It appears that over 20 years ago the father of the bride, who is a man of somewhat high standing amongst his race of people, and well-known as "Johnny Smith," was married at Long Crendon Church, by the Rev. T. Hayton, and it is said that, by his expressed wish, the ceremony of Monday was also celebrated in the same Church, and the service also read by the Rev. T. Hayton. The bride, Lemantina Smith, does not change her name, as her husband is also one of the numerous Smith family, excepting to distinguish her from others, when she may be called after her husband, as Mrs. Nathan Smith. The ceremony took place at eleven o'clock, by which time there were assembled a great number of friends of the bride and bridegroom, many of whom had come long distances to be present at the marriage. The proceedings were of a very orderly character throughout, the Churchwardens, Messrs. W. Crook and S. Cook, being present, and doing all in their power for the comfort and convenience of the assembly. As the party left the Church the bells rang out a merry peal, and the parties more immediately concerned adjourned to the Angel Inn, where the bride's father presented her with her wedding dowry, which was said to be a pint of sovereigns, and where also a substantial dinner was provided for the wedding party and their guests.
