Defendant did not appear, but sent his wife. Police-constable Dooley proved that there was an encampment on the highway, and said this was a common practice among the gipsies. He had received many complaints from farmers, many of whom had lost sheep, worried by the dogs the travellers had with them. The cattle, and horses, and goats belonging to the gipsies were also straying. There was a separate charge preferred for cattle straying, and Mrs. Jemima Harrison, the owner of another caravan, was charged with encamping, and also with permitting four horses and two goats to stray.
