1890	8 July	Faringdon, BRK	in magistrates court	George Hodges, late of Longworth, shooting saloon proprietor, was summoned for allowing five horses to stray on the Abingdon-road, on the 23rd June, - Pleaded not guilty P.C. Porchmouth deposed to watching the horses for a quarter of an hour. They were feeding by the side of the road, between the "Lamb and Flag" and the Charney Cross-roads, and no one was with them. The defendant had his vans in the yard of the public-house, and when he (the constable) called his attention to the horses he said they had not been there five minutes, but afterwards he repeatedly asked him not to report it, and said "A bit of silver in your pocket would be much better than summoning me." - Defendant said the last horse had not been unharnessed three minutes, and the horses were on the way to the field The Bench convicted, and imposed a fine of 10s., and 10s. costs The defendant paid the money, and left the Court muttering something about "paid magistrates" and "truth telling policemen."
