1897	17 August	Wirksworth, DBY	charged in magistrates court but did not appear	At the Petty Sessions on Tuesday, Thomas Horobin, a gipsy, was charged with using the highway at Brassington for an encampment, contrary to the law, on 28th July. Defendant did not appear, but sent his wife. Police-constable Dooley proved that there was an encampment on the highway, and said this was a common practice among the gipsies. He had received many complaints from farmers, many of whom had lost sheep, worried by the dogs the travellers had with them. The cattle, and horses, and goats belonging to the gipsies were also straying. There was a separate charge preferred for cattle straying, and Mrs. Jemima Harrison, the owner of another caravan, was charged with encamping, and also with permitting four horses and two goats to stray. The Bench raised a point of law as to whether this act of the defendants constituted an obstruction to anyone, and whether there was any damage done to the highway. Captain Vernon Mellor elicited the fact that the defendants had fires, Eventually the defendants were both fined for cattle straying, and the cases for encamping were reserved for the next court.			<i>The Derby Mercury</i> , 18 August 1897, 3
