1861	24 June	Cambridge, CAM	in magistrates court	Mr. Potts, the brewer, charged an old gipsy man, named <i>Moses Harris</i> , with being one of five who robbed him of his watch and guard at the fair about mid night on Saturday. The complainant stated that he was passing the gipsys' tents on Saturday night, when he saw a dog come out and stare at him. A man came up and complainant asked if the dog were savage, and he was answered in the negative. Whilst conversing with the one man, a second, third and fourth came up, and witness soon found his watch and chain gone. He collared the prisoner out of the four and gave him into custody. P.-c. George Studd, stationed at Whelnetnam, said that on the Sunday morning, about half-past eleven o'clock, he received information from Mr. Nunn's farm baliff that four horses were straying on the highway at Great Whelnetnam, in Bells-lane. He went and found the horses on what is known as Brook's Green, on the way to Hawstead. The van to which they belonged was on Hawstead Green, over a quarter of a mile off. Defendant's grandfather, William Harris, to whom the van belongs, went after the horses, and since then had hired a meadow to put them in. - Defendant said the horses didn't leave Brooks' Green [sic]. - Wm. Cocks, farm bailiff to Mr. Nunn, said that about ten o'clock on the morning in question he saw four horses in a narrow part of Bells-lane - two on each side, about 100 yards off Brook's Green. Witness could not see any one with them. About half-past eleven o'clock he saw the horses on Brook's Green ; there was no one with them then. He had had considerable damage done by horses, but of course he couldn't say if these were the ones. Defendant called Mary, wife of David Jarmin, who said the horses were in her meadow at night, near Brook's Green, and on the morning in question they were let out about nine o'clock. They were on the green until about twelve o'clock, when the policeman came they didn't go off once. -The witness Cocks said the horses were 150 yards off the woman's house when he first saw them. -The magistrates having considered the case in private, the Chairman said defendant was convicted of an exactly similar offence on the 20th November, when he was fined 1s. each horse, and the costs, 7s. 6d. He would now be fined 1s. 6d. each horse, with the costs 4s. 6d., making in all 10s. 6d. - Defendant said he could not pay ; he should have to go to gaol.
