1911	late February	Sutton-on-Trent, NTT	death	The chief of a caravan of gipsies which halted at Sutton-on-Trent last week end on account of his illness, has died there at the ripe age of 100 years. The remains of deceased were placed in a large oak coffin together with a great many personal belongings and sent to Leeds for interment. Before resuming their itinerary the gipsies burnt the chief's caravan and belongings in the centre of camp as bidden in his last injunction. FUNERAL PYRE AT SUTTON-ON-TRENT. CARAVAN AND BELONGINGS BURNED. A strange story of the ways of the gipsy comes from Sutton-on-Trent, near Newark. A calvacade of the wandering tribe travelled through Newark on the North Road last week-end. When they arrived at Sutton, eight miles north of the town, a halt was made because of the illness of their leader and venerable chief. The old man was reputed to be 100 years of age, and his condition gave the tribe some concern. By permission of a local farmer the caravans were drawn up in a field near the village, and the camp was pitched. The medicine art of the gipsies proved ineffectual to stay the old chief's illness, so the local doctor was called in to attend him. He ministered to his strange patient assiduously, but Nature insisted upon the payment of her debt, and to the grief of his tribe the chief passed away. His valedictory messages and instructions to his people were received with awe, and carried out to the letter with a religious devotion. An oak coffin, large enough to contain the body and the choicest belongings of the deceased, was made by the local carpenter, and in due course the remains were taken to Leeds for interment there by the side of the deceased's relatives. A strange incident and custom was performed before the camp struck and the caravans moved on. In the presence of the mourning gipsies, the moving domicile of the chief and all the relics and furnishings of his caravan were moved into the centre of the camp and fired. 1911	late February	Sutton-on-Trent, NTT	burial	In connection with the death of Isaac Herne, the famous gipsy chief, and the curious proceedings associated with his funeral, reported in "The Yorkshire Post" of yesterday, a representative of "The Yorkshire Evening Post" had an interesting chat yesterday morning with the Rev. Herbert Malleon, the vicar of Manston, who was a close friend of the dead gipsy's, and who, in accordance with his expressed wishes, superintended the interment at Manston. Mr. Malleon explained that the late chief came from one of the oldest known Romany families, and was a pure-bred gipsy, without, so far as can be traced, a single drop of Georgio blood in his veins. His exact age is not known. There are those of his tribe who declare him to have been a centenarian, but so far as there is authority to show his age was "about ninety," and he had a pedigree and an escutcheon as long and as undefiled as might have excited the envy and admiration of many an English aristocrat. He was a son of another well-known gipsy, Nearbei Herne, and his mother was Sinfie, who was called "The Crow," doubtless because of her swarthy complexion and the raven blackness of her curly locks. She it was who is always supposed to have been the instructress of George Borrow in the intricacies and mysteries of the pure Romany tongue. Isaac, indeed, had a very lively recollection of the famous author, and to those with whom he would condescend to speak familiarly he delighted to recall his memories of him. 				Romany, a daughter of Pyramus Grey. He leaves three children, one son, Eza Herne, and two daughters, whilst one child died some years ago. A numerous family of grandchildren survive him, however. It is about five years since his wife died, and on that occasion similar funeral rites were observed to those which were enacted the other day in his own case. Her caravan, a very elaborate and costly affair, and all her belongings, were taken by her husband and burned as a funeral pyre. All who knew the late Isaac Herne, and were privileged to speak with him on terms of equality, describe him as an extremely able and shrewd old man, with a dignity about him which the ordinary city dweller would probably not understand. His conversation was full of interest, and he had many good stories to tell of what he had seen on his long treks in the country. His speech is said to have been poetry in itself, and yet in the stirring days of his adventurous youth he earned the reputation amongst his kinsfolk of being a formidable fighting man. He was, in common with all well-bred gipsies, exceptionally polite and courteous ; indeed his old fashioned gallantry and old-world courtesy had something Eastern about it, something Oriental, which was in strange contrast to his surroundings, and an odd accompaniment to his shrewd business-like air when he was engaged in concluding a deal in horses.

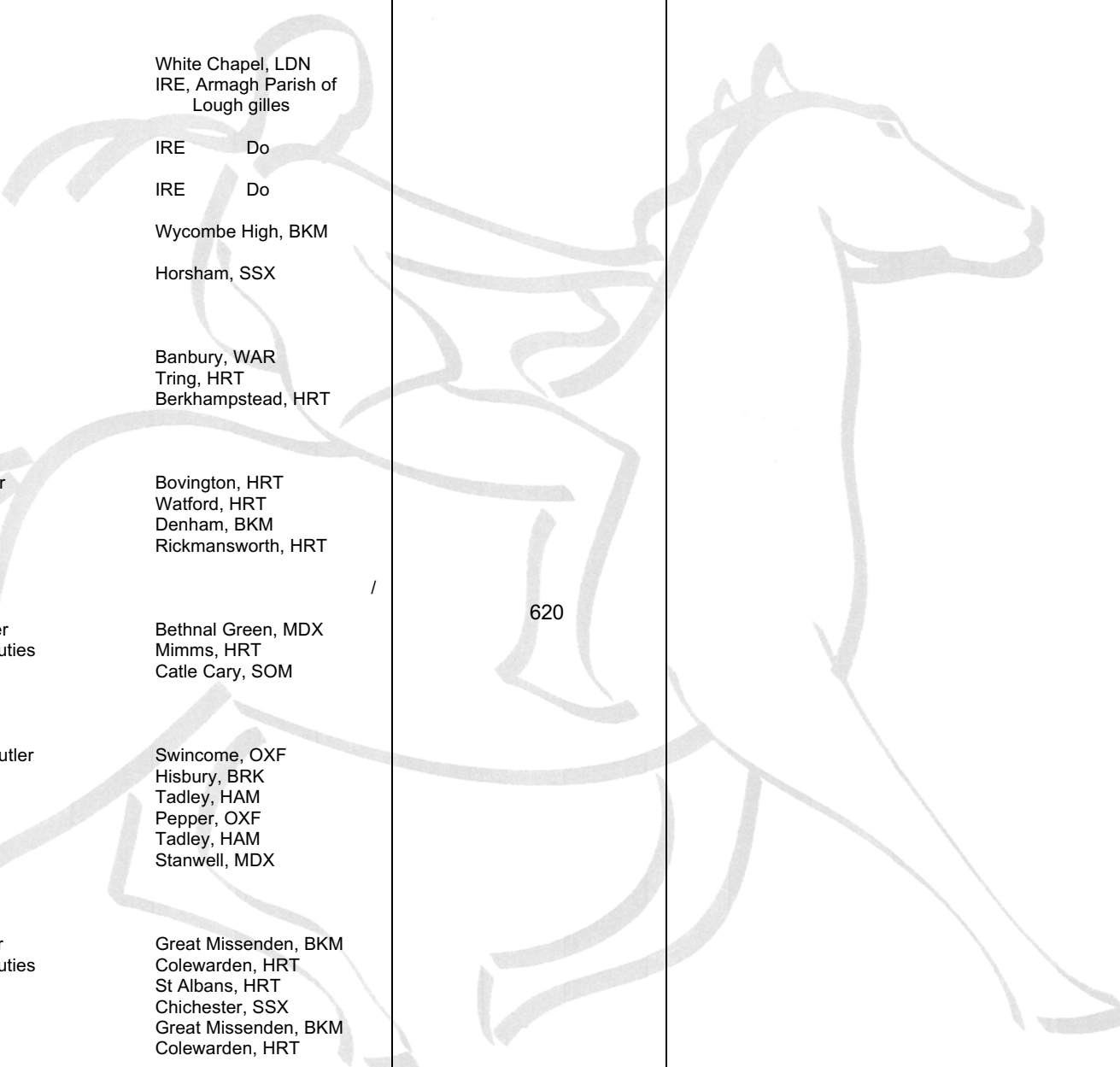
