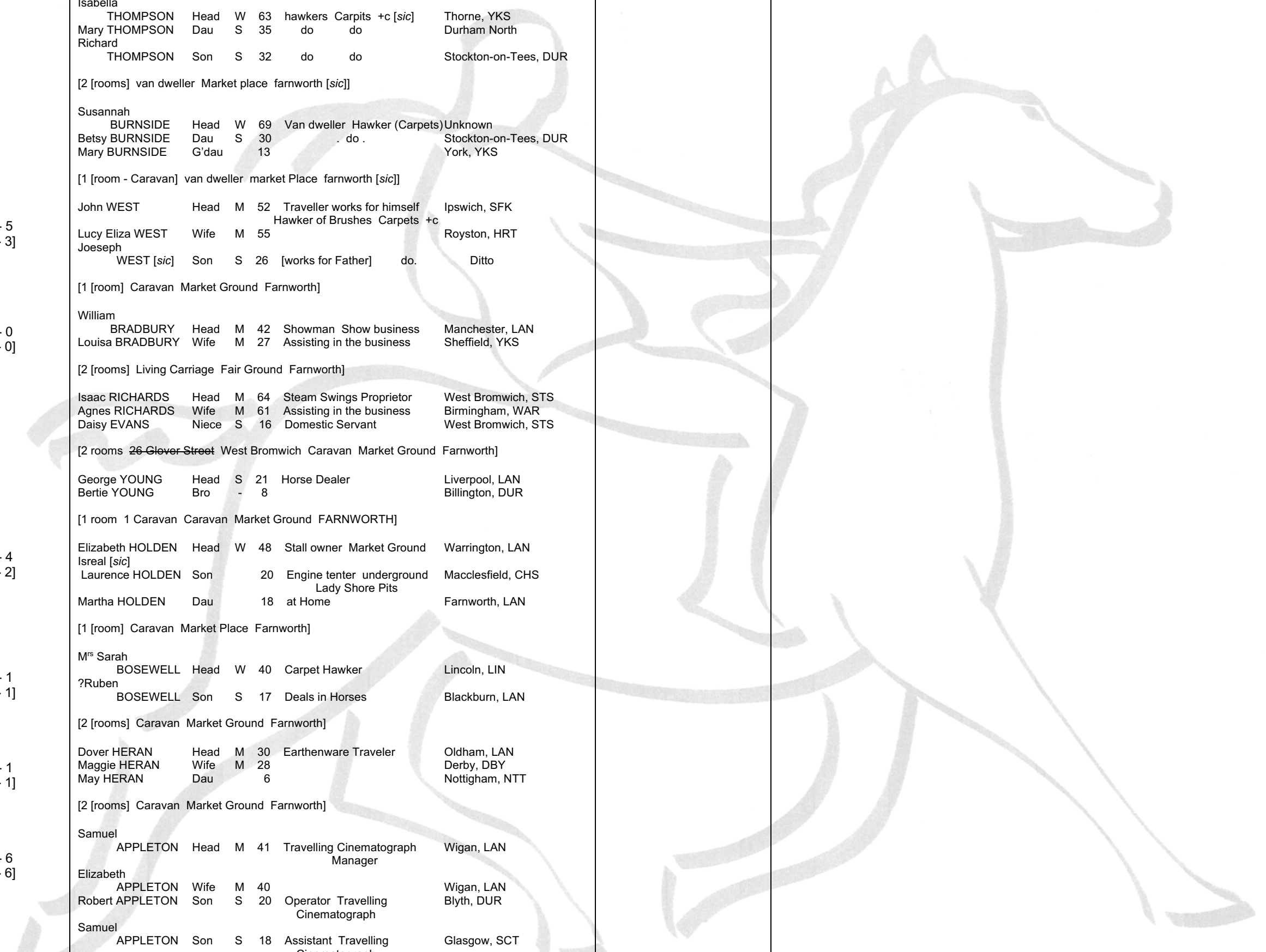

				<p>The victim of the latest cycling accident is well-known in this district. He has been coming here at varying intervals for many years past, and, being one of the so-called "gipsy" class, he pitched his tent near the green patch better known as "the gipsies' green," at Mumbles-road. Williams, who was between 66 and 70 years of age, was on one of his periodical visits to the town, having arrived a day or two previously. He had been to Swansea vending his goods, and, with his pony and trap, was proceeding along the Mumbles-road on Friday evening. He had got beyond Sketty-road, leading the pony, when Wm. John Davies (17), living at Trewyddfa-road, Morriston, by some means collided with him. The old man was caught in the stomach by the cycle, and knocked down. Williams remained on the ground in a dazed condition. Several people who were on the road immediately rushed to his assistance, and the youth remained on the spot.</p> <p>P.C. Jones, stationed at Blackpill, was at once communicated with, and, finding Williams in a state of collapse, procured a trap and had him promptly conveyed to the Swansea Hospital. When they arrived at that institution, it was found that he had passed away, never regaining consciousness. It is presumed that Williams, in falling to the ground, struck his head with considerable force, and sustained a fracture...</p> <p>INQUEST ON WILLIAMS'S BODY AT THE SWANSEA HOSPITAL.</p> <p>P.C. Robert Jones...learned that deceased was a travelling hawkker, and had been knocking about the place since his wife died several years ago...</p> <p>YOUNG CYCLIST TELLS HIS SAD STORY.</p> <p>Wm. John Davies, 33, Trewyddfa-road, Morriston, the rider of the bicycle, was next examined. He said he was coming from Mumbles to Swansea. He did not know when he left Mumbles, but it was considerably after ten o'clock when the accident happened. He saw Williams when a few yards from him near the Gipsies' Green at the Mumbles end. Deceased was on the wrong side of the road, and was leading a pony. There were two cyclists in front, and both nearly knocked Williams over. Williams's head was down, and he could not see him coming. Witness rang his bell, and tried to keep to the proper side of the road, the left side. At first Williams did not move, and witness turned outwards. Just then the gipsy made to go to the other side, and witness ran into him, and knocked him down...</p> <p>Walter Resignol said he never heard any complaints as to the way the cyclist was riding. One of the gipsy women told him that the defendant had been drinking.</p> <p>THE CONDITION OF THE DECEASED MAN.</p> <p>Beatrice Herring, a Gipsy woman, said defendant was her uncle. He had been drinking before the accident. He was not deaf, and was a healthy man.</p> <p>Charles Loveridge, another Gipsy, said deceased was "so pretty well drunk that he could not walk." He was in that condition when witness saw him before the accident.</p> <p>DAVIES EXONERATED FROM BLAME.</p> <p>The Coroner, in summing up, explained that the accident had happened through Williams getting in the way of the cyclist. Davies was on the right side of the road, and had done his best to get clear when he saw deceased. It was a miracle to him that a large number of gipsy children were not killed. He saw two crossing the tramway the other day, and it was really a miracle how they escaped being knocked down. If gipsy people looked after their children as well as they looked after their dogs, it would be better for them. They had some beautiful dogs, and kept them wonderfully clean, but the children seemed to go about any way they liked...</p>

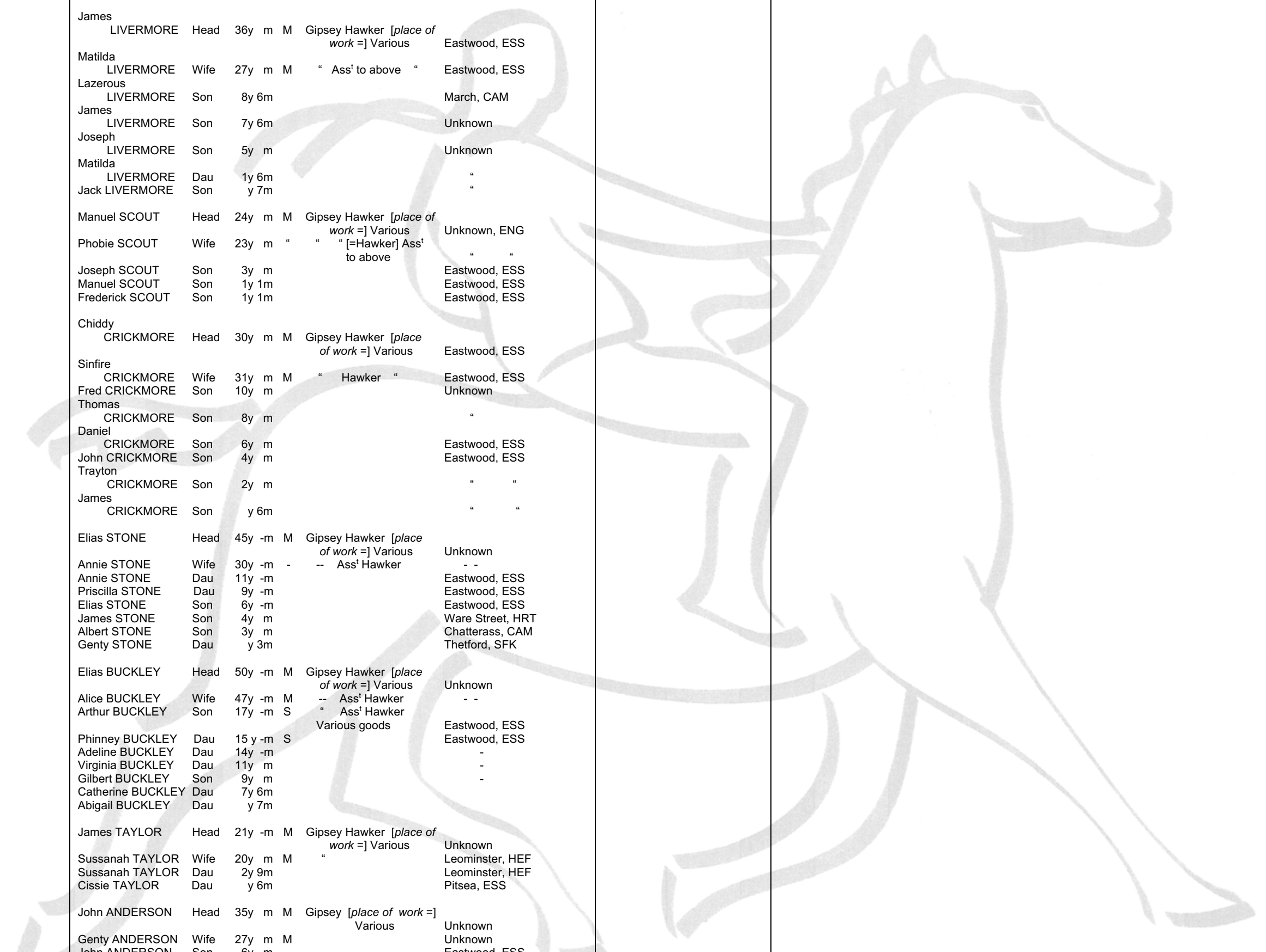
