1890	1 September	North Luffenham, LIN	accidental death of Silvester	TERRIBLE FATALITY. - A fatal accident, and one, taking all the circumstances into consideration, unexampled in the annals of this neighbourhood, took place in this village on Monday last, whereby a youth, aged twenty-one, and almost blind, was burnt to death. In order to assist in the ingathering of the harvest, a party of gipsies had come	<i>The Grantham Journal</i> , 6 September 1890, 2

				into the district, and erected an impromptu sort of a tent in a field belonging to Mr. Lambert, by whom they were engaged. Amongst this party was a man named Absalom Smith, and his son Silvester, as we have remarked above nearly blind, and quite incapacitated from taking any part in ordinary labour. On Monday morning, the father went to his work, leaving the youth in charge of his sister, a girl of eleven, and all went well until a little after ten. At that time, he was working only about two hundred yards from the tent, when his employer, Mr. Lambert, called to him, "Your hut's affire." He at once rushed to it, to find his son burnt to death inside. Deceased had been lying on some straw, which was only about two feet from the cooking fire, and it is supposed a cinder had ignited his resting place. Both his father and son lived in Billesdon, in which village the sad event has caused a deep feeling of gloom. The inquest was held at the Fox and Hounds Inn, on Tuesday, before the Coroner for the district (W. Keal, Esq.) of Oakham...After viewing the body, the first witness called was Absalom Smith, who deposed that deceased was his son, and was twenty-one years of age the previous April. Witness was carrying some pens for Mr. Thos. Lambert on Monday morning. His nephew was also working for Mr. Lambert, though the latter was not there on the Monday. They had a tent made of four hurdles, and one of Mr. Lambert's cloths. They laid on a bit of straw, and had been there about a fortnight. The deceased was nearly blind ; he could see things at a short distance, but could do no work. He had been blind from birth. On Monday morning, witness started work about 6.15, when he had his breakfast with deceased. They had a fire to cook with, which was about four or five feet from the front of the hut. Deceased was finishing his breakfast when witness left. He saw deceased again at lunch time, about 9.30 o'clock. He then returned to work, and left deceased sitting where he had had lunch, which was the last time he saw him alive. About 10.15 , when he was some two hundred yards off, Mr. Lambert said, "Your hut's afire," and he ran away. Deceased was burning, and he (witness) pulled him out dead. Everything was burnt. Witness' little daughter, aged twelve, also lunched with him and deceased, and she was with deceased when witness returned to work. Deceased was generally all right in his head, but was always troubling himself because he could not get his living. It would be about twenty minutes from when he returned to work to when he found the tent on fire. He (witness) was not watching the tent, though it was in sight. Deceased was lying on the straw. (Witness, who was an old man, was much affected during the giving of his evidence.) – Florence Smith (11), sister of the deceased, remembered being at lunch in the tent with her brother the previous day. Her father left about 10.15 to go back to work. Her father had just got to the brow of the hill, and she was going to obtain some water, when she saw the smoke and fire, and came back again at once. She got to the tent before her father ; then she went and fetched him, and also to get some water to put out the flames, and her brother was dead when she came back. Her brother was not smoking – he never did. The straw was about that much (indicating about a foot and a half on the table) from the fire, because she turned it up before leaving. – The Coroner, in summing up, said he thought there was nothing very puzzling about the case, as a mere spark would be sufficient to set the place on fire, and the tent being full of smoke, even if not blind the young man would be unable to find his way out. – The Jury, after a few minutes' deliberation, returned a unanimous verdict of "Accidental death," and gave thier fees to the deceased's father.
