She was likewise indicted a second time for pretending her self to be an Egyptian, and having familiarity with evil Spirits, and pretending by Magick Arts she could discover where Treasure was hid, and did wander up and down from the 21st. day of January until the 17th. day of June next following; with her Insinuations she persuaded one Mr. Richardson's Daughter that there was Treasure hid in the House: She likewise desired that she might see some of Mr. Richardson's Goods, and his Daughter let her see three Gold Rings, a Silver-hafted Knife and Fork, a Silver Bottle, and a Silver Box; which she bid the young Damsel put under her Apron, and carry them into the Cellar, where she said the Treasure was hid, but she secretly took the things from under her Apron, and when the young Woman was gone to find her supposed Treasure, she made her Escape with the Goods. 1888	27 September	Stevenage, HRT	in magistrates court	THE FAIR AT HAULTWICK. - At the Stevenage Petty Sessions, on Thursday, <i>George Manning, Joseph Brinkley, Sidney Johnson, Susan Smith, James Draper</i>, and <i>John Fox</i>, travelling hawkers, &c., were charged with obstructing the highway at Haultwick, Little Munden, by pitching certain stalls or stands thereon. - The question raised by this case was whether the fair at Haultwick was for one or two days. The complainant, Police-constable Hyatt, urged that it was only held on one day, while the defendants contended that from time immemorial it had been a two-days' fair. They produced a written statement purporting to be signed by several of the inhabitants setting forth that the fair lasted two days, but as this was not evidence the Magistrates could not act upon it. - Supt. Reynolds said he had made enquiries and found that many years ago vans and stalls used to stop in the village for three or four days, and sometimes for a week. Now complaints were made when the fair people stopped more that one day [sic]. 1919	1 September	Hull, YKS		Serious Hessle Road Affair. WIFE STRUCK WITH AXE. Some excitement was caused in the Hessle-road district yesterday, when a quarrel took place between Kenza Johnson (37), of 10, Providence-place, Wassand-street, and his wife, Alice Johnson (36). About 3.30 p.m. yesterday afternoon, people in the terrace heard noises as of quarrelling in the house. It is alleged that Johnson, in his anger, picked up an axe, and struck his wife on the head with it. She at once left the house and ran into a neighbour's house ; Johnson then struck himself with the axe. The police were called, and when a constable arrived he went into the house and saw the wife bleeding from a wound in the head. P.C. Lambert asked her what was the matter, and she replied, "My husband has struck me with an axe." P.C. Lambert then went across to Johnson's house, leaving the wife in the care of P.C. Shaw, and found Johnson lying on his back in the backyard, with the axe by his side. The constable asked, "Now, Johnson, what has happened?" "IS SHE DEAD?" Johnson replied, "What have I done? Is she dead [?] Is she dead?" P.C. Lambert replied, "Dead! no." Johnson then said "Not dead ! and I have hit her with this axe." Husband and wife were taken to the Infirmary, and the wife was detained in a critical condition. The husband, after being attended to, was arrested. At the Hull Police Court this morning, before Mr John Watson and Mr G. F. Grant, Johnson was charged with maliciously wounding his wife by striking her with a hatchet, and also with attempting to commit suicide. Supt. Boyes, who prosecuted, asked for a remand. He stated the facts as given above. P.C. Lambert gave evidence of arrest, and said that the wife was detained at the Infirmary suffering from a wound in the head, and a fractured knee. She was progressing favourably, but was unable to attend court. Supt. Boyes explaind that accused had for some time past acted very strangely, and he had been attended by three doctors, who stated that something was wrong mentally. Accused was remanded to September 8th pro forma. Mr. G. S. Williamson, who defended, applied for bail, but this was refused. Accused was discharged from the Army six months ago.
