She told Lee of what had occurred when she returned crying to the camp. - Cross-examined by Mr. Bullen, she admitted that the story was "got up" by the Lees, but immediately afterwards told the judge that her evidence was perfectly true. The man named Lee was brought up from Kingston Prison to give evidence. He was twenty years old, and she had lived with him as his wife rather more than twelve months. He was in custody for stealing some ferrets, and would be released from prison next morning.
